PASTOR'S PEN

Lent is a time for reflection and transformation culminating with our Easter celebration, celebrating new life. When you Google transformation you get all kinds of links to bodily transformations. There is a 30, 60, 90 day transformation program for all kinds of workouts. There is a cost to transformation and that is discipline. It is consistently doing the work.

Transformation of our spiritual body follows the same principles. Our Lenten season is a 40 day process, where we, like Jesus, are challenged to get real with ourselves. The devil, or deceitful one, is masterful at using our ego to justify itself and sabotage the desire to become more attuned in our relationships and more peaceful within ourselves.

It is common to use the example of the butterfly. The caterpillar has to shut itself up in a chrysalis from which it must break out. If the caterpillar has help getting out of the chrysalis it will be unable to take flight. Dedication and work are needed for transformation.

The word lent means spring, a time of new life. When we consider our spiritual workout, Lent reminds us that time for reflection in our relationships is absolutely necessary if we are going to transform our lives, spread our wings and take flight.


Lutheran Night at The Phillies in Honor of Dick Reimet
