Trusting in the mercy of God, let us confess our sin.


Silence for reflection and self-examination.





anguish in my heart. ³For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my own people, my kindred according to the flesh. ⁴They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises; ⁵to them belong the patriarchs, and from them, according to the flesh, comes the Messiah, who is over all, God blessed forever. Amen.





DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNION

All baptized Christians are welcome to share the bread and wine of **Holy Communion**. Please come forward and pick up your "Fellowship Cup", an all-in-one wafer and juice set (the bread and wine) from the center table. The pastor says "The Body of Christ given for you." and the assistant minister says, "The Blood of Christ shed for you." **You may then move to the table on either side of the front aisle while maintaining social distancing.** (Hint: you may want to rest your "Fellowship Cup" on the side table to steady it). Remove your mask, open the top protective film to uncover the "body" (an unleavened wafer), place in your mouth then open the 2nd protective film to uncover the "blood" (100% grape juice)


and drink. Please dispose of your cup in the receptacle provided, replace your mask and return to your seat.



- You MUST wear a mask. Please do not remove them while in the building. There will be supplies at church if you do not have one to bring.
