I would like to share with you this "Blessing when the world is ending" by Jan Richardson, from her book, *Circle of Grace: A Book of Blessings for the Seasons*

Look, the world is always ending somewhere.

Somewhere the sun has come crashing down.

Somewhere it has gone completely dark.

Somewhere it has ended with the gun, the knife, the fist.

Somewhere it has ended with the slammed door, the shattered hope.

Somewhere it has ended with the utter quiet that follows the news from the phone, the television, the hospital room.

It is simply here because there is nothing a blessing is better suited for than an ending, nothing that cries out more for a blessing than when a world is falling apart.


This blessing will not fix you, will not mend you, will not give you false comfort; it will not talk to you about one door opening when another one closes.




We are ordering **Poinsettia Plants** to adorn our Altar area at Christmas.

As we enter Advent and the Christmas season, our thoughts turn toward the greatest gift of all that GOD gave us, his Son Jesus, and Salvation through Grace. As we think about our blessings, we need to ask all of us to consider our church. Unfortunately we continue to see a decline in giving through the pandemic. We need to ask all of us to prayerfully consider *what more we can do to help our church*.

For those coming in person please remember we have offering plates to receive your gifts. We have resumed “passing the plates”. But if you are uncomfortable with passing, then please use the plates before the service or as you leave (Please see our Bulletin for specifics.)

For those doing church virtually we ask you to please consider mailing a check for your offering to the church office. (We are pursuing getting an easy process on our web site and Facebook for virtual donations....more to come on that soon!).

Recall we had our special Congregational meeting on September 26th and voted to take a loan to repay the \$13,136.00 plus accumulated interest that was not forgiven under the PPP program. That new monthly bill will be \$302.62/month. Please prayerfully consider what you may be able to do *incrementally*, to help our church to pay this back. Any donations you make toward this will go to pay this new monthly bill. Just make a note on your donations that they are for the PPP loan.

Finally our Advent Coin folders are now available as you enter the church. Just ask our greeter for one.

All your gifts to Immanuel (Time, Talents and Treasures) equip our Church to fulfill our mission even during these unique and challenging COVID times.

Let's do our best to provide generous support so we can continue our Mission doing God's Work....the best we can for now (keep using Face Masks, Social distancing, washing of hands, following CDC guidelines and seeking a vaccine/booster).



THE BIRTH OF JESUS

Luke 2:1-20

² In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. ² (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) ³ And everyone went to their own town to register.

⁴ So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. ⁵ He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. ⁶ While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, ⁷ and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

⁸ And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night.

⁹ An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. ¹⁰ But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. ¹¹ Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. ¹² This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

¹³ Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying,

¹⁴ "Glory to God in the highest heaven,
and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests."

¹⁵ When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

¹⁶ So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. ¹⁷ When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, ¹⁸ and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. ¹⁹ But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. ²⁰ The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.
