

THE PASTOR'S PEN

Cleansing the temple. John 2:13-19: there is a striking difference between the marriage in Cana and this one at the temple in Jerusalem. At the wedding, Jesus was an invited guest who pleased the people. In the Jerusalem temple, Jesus was an uninvited stranger in his Father's house, whose display of anger and judgement shocked those in attendance.



Jesus referred to his body as a temple, meaning that it is the sanctuary of the living God. He said, "Destroy this temple and I will raise it again in three days." The apostle Paul understood our bodies to be the temple of the Holy Spirit. He wrote the Corinthians that they were to honor their bodies, both physically and spiritually. Paul taught that our bodies are to be a living example of disciplined holiness, that God might be revealed through us.

What do we find when we examine our lives? Are we a pure sanctuary that enables people to see and experience the love and power of Christ? We spend so much time on outer appearances, and devote little time to the inner life. Our New Year's resolutions are often focused on obtaining the perfect body versus focusing on obtaining a perfect soul.

The Jerusalem temple was an architectural masterpiece that impressed those who came to worship. But the world of sin penetrated its courts,




