As schools are out and most people's thoughts turn toward vacation time, traveling, seeing new sights and getting refreshed, unfortunately in some cases their giving to the church also takes a "vacation", hence the term "Summer Slump" as it relates to giving. And since (also unfortunately) our bills just keep on coming, this can drive us into the red. We are starting to see this and would ask for you to help us "**Stop the Summer Slump**"! After all, God's amazing generosity never takes time off. Thankfully for all of us!!

#### So What Can You Do?

- Do your best to give regularly and if you do miss a week, please try and make it up.
- Support our fund raisers especially the ongoing **Food Gift Coupons**.

#### Make Giving Easy and Automatic. Here are two ways you can do that:

- 1. Your Bank You can set up a monthly cashier's check to be drawn on one of your accounts and mailed to the church. This is a recurring process so you don't have to worry about it! For example Wells Fargo will help you set this up at no cost to you! Contact your bank and they can help you set it up.
- 2. **Tithely** Consider using the safe, secure, easy virtual method with the QR code with your smart phone. There are also buttons on our website and Facebook pages. Tithely can also set up a recurring, automatic monthly donation using one of your credit cards. There is a nominal fee with this.



Our Roof Repair Campaign is underway with material being placed on order by our Contractor for the Slate repairs.



We have slate pieces from our roof falling! The Property Committee investigated with a slate roof specialist, who inspected our roofs. The repairs of the slate, plus 2 other items needing attention (Gutter repairs and Flat Roof maintenance), will cost about <u>\$5,350</u>. We are focusing on the <u>slate repairs</u> <u>first</u> which will cost about \$3600. Our Roof Repair campaign has raised over \$1,700. so far! Our sincere Thanks to those who have already given. Please support this effort as we work together to care for our Lord's house.


