## PASTOR'S PEN

May is a great month, the weather is getting warmer and Memorial day is just around the corner. Did you know that May 5<sup>th</sup> is the National Day of Prayer? In light of this I thought it would be a good idea to talk about prayer, specifically intercessory prayer.



Intercession comes from the root to intercede. So prayers of intercession are prayer for others. Have you ever noticed that there is a structure to the prayers? Perhaps before we get started we should think about why we pray in the first place. We pray because the Bible commands us to (Matthew 6:5; Romans 12:12 to give two

examples.). Prayer is how we communicate with God and participate in his works. It grants us the privilege of experiencing God, keeps us humble and strengthens the bonds between believers.

We start with prayers for our nation, but why? God answers the prayers of his people. In 2 Chronicles 7:14, the Lord instructs as in the importance of praying for our nation. Ask God to move in your neighborhood and community. Pray that people will turn to His mercy and seek His will for our land.

Sometimes separate, sometimes joined, we pray for Leaders. The Bible instruct us to pray for our leaders (Feel free to Google). We are told to pray for our leaders “that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness (1 Tim. 2:2). We pray that leaders will seek and serve God in a manner that is worthy of their positions of authority.

We also pray for our families. The family is an institution ordained by God. A healthy family should be a place of love, support, spiritual

Children and caregivers are invited


