# Coming Soon: "Graced by the Fruits of Our Labor"

On Sunday, November 6th, we begin a three-week program called *Graced by the Fruits of Our Labor*. Our theme verse is from Ephesians 6:7: "*Serve wholeheartedly, as if you are serving the Lord, not men.*" We serve wholeheartedly when we give wholeheartedly in service to the Lord. In our resolve to serve wholeheartedly in Christ's name, we put our faith and trust in the Lord into action. Through this program, we all will grow to understand a little more clearly what it means to be a Christian whose purpose is to serve, not to be served.



God has created, forgiven, and redeemed us, his instruments of love and compassion in the world. God blesses us so we can serve him by serving others. 


