# Could You Please Consider: CATCHING UP and/or STEPPING UP?



The dreaded "summer slump" in giving has hit Immanuel very hard this summer. While we do understand that vacation, inflation and life in general, can and does interrupt our good intentions, the Resource Committee sincerely regrets having to report that Immanuel will incur a shortfall in the General Fund of about \$2000 by September 1<sup>st</sup>, even with delayed payments on some bills. To our faithful givers, **THANK YOU!!** To those who may have fallen behind in giving, we urge you to please consider: **Catching Up** and/or **Stepping Up** on your contributions. Remember God's amazing generosity never takes time off, thankfully for all of us!!

#### What did we do already?

- On August 11<sup>th</sup> Council approved a motion to take \$2000 from Memorial fund in August.
- On August 11<sup>th</sup> Council approved a motion to liquidate \$3000 from our investments\* at Ameriprise to pay some bills we had to hold, regain our footing going into the fall and (hopefully) buy some time for the **Catch Up**, **Step Up** effort to help.

(Please Note: Our Investments\* grand total is approximately \$44,000. That's it. When that is gone, it is gone).



#### So What Else Can You Do?

- Do your best to give regularly and if you do miss a week, please try and make it up.
- If you have the ability to give a little more to help us out of the summer slump, that would be a blessing!
- Support our fund raisers especially the ongoing Food Gift Coupons.

#### Make Giving Easy and Automatic. Here are two ways you can do that:

- 1. Your Bank You can set up a monthly cashier's check to be drawn on one of your accounts and mailed to the church. This is a recurring process so you don't have to worry about it! For example Wells Fargo will help you set this up at no cost to you! Contact your bank and they can help you set it up.
- 2. **Tithely** Consider using the safe, secure, easy virtual method with the QR code with your smart phone. There are also buttons on our website and Facebook pages. Tithely can also set up a recurring, automatic monthly donation using one of your credit cards. There is a nominal fee with this.



IMPORTANT: If you have set up automatic giving, PLEASE confirm that the funds are actually getting to the church!

Our Roof Repair is underway! Slate repairs are done! No more work will happen until more funds are raised. We had slate pieces from our roof falling. The Property Committee investigated with a slate roof specialist, who inspected our roofs. The priority repairs of the slate were completed in July thanks in part to those who contributed \$2,305. thus far. 2 other items need attention: Gutter repairs and Flat Roof maintenance. That will cost about \$2,000. more. We will hold off on that work until added funds for the roof come in. Our sincere Thanks to those who have already given. Please support this effort as we work together to care for our Lord's house.

We are looking forward to next year!




