
American Red Cross Blood Donation Drive has been scheduled

Immanuel's Mural Celebrates 80 years on October 13th

Our church was blessed 80 years ago with the magnificent mural that adorns the rear wall of our Sanctuary. As you have seen in the bulletin with our "Look Up" and Enjoy! articles, we want to celebrate this 80 year milestone. We will be doing that on Sunday October 13th during our 11AM service followed by a coffee hour with a special birthday cake! We have invited people from several local Historical and Art groups plus the Lutheran Historical Society to attend as well. We hope we'll have additional guests that day to enjoy the mural with us.

Here are some "fun facts" about the mural:

• Originally dedicated in 1939 it took nearly 2 years to complete. It depicts 3 scenes from the life of Jesus with the central scene being the Sermon on the Mount. It is nearly 70 feet across.





- The other 2 scenes on each side show Jesus with Mary Magdalene (on the left) and Jesus with the blind beggars (on the right).
- It was painted by Miriam Tindall Smith (1901-1984), who was born in Norwood, in memory of her Mother, Jennie Minerva Tindall.
- Miriam Tindall Smith was a renowned artist, member of the Philadelphia Art Alliance who
 had major works exhibited in Art Institute of Chicago, Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine
 Arts, 1939 New York's World Fair to name a few.....
- She has murals, in addition to ours, at New York Central & Santa Fe Railroad Headquarters, Children's ward in the University of Pennsylvania Hospital, Baptist Hospital in Shelby, North Carolina and the Cleveland Museum of Art.
