INDIAN RIVER WOMEN'S GROUP

In 1995 Mary A, had a thought that an evening women's group in Indian River County would do just fine. First she contacted the St. Augustine Episcopal; Church to make arrangements for a Monday night meeting and with several other ladies announcements were made at the Popular Vero Beach group which met on Sunday evenings with anywhere from 200 to 300 people in attendance..

In May 1995 the first meeting was held, At that time the meeings were "Open" and alternated between "12&12" and "Big Book" studies. The early members were: Mary A. (Founder); Robin N (GSR). Beth F. (Central Office); Allene M (Treasurer) and Beverly B. (Chair). Two more early members were Judy R and Julie O.

Over the years group has gone from "Open" to "Closed" back to "Open. Free babysitting was offered until Covid reared its ugly head in 2020. During the Pandemic the group, unable to meet in person, created a virtual presence using the Zoom platforn through May 2021. Due to circumstances an alternate location for the meeting was looked for and the group started meeting at the Unitarian Universal Fellowship on 27th Avenue with the meeting time changing to 7:00 pm instead of 8:00pn.

The group, since its inception, has strived be use the 12 Traditions in its service to the AA community at large and Alcoholic women in particular. As a result from a Group Inventory the group has opted to have greeters welcoming all ladies as they come through the door. In addition the group has created a Social Committee to plan fellowship events for the group that is open to recovering women.

The group has participated in bringing meetings to treatment facilities such as Alcohope and later Gate Lodge and the Behavioral Health Center. They have served on committees and lend helping hands at various Birthday Dinners, Gratitude Dinners, Alkathons, Quarterly Assemblies when District 6 was hosting as well as sitting the desk at the Central Office answering calls for information and/or help in addition to after hours phone duties. Several of the members have made themselves available for 12 Step Calls and are listed as such at the Central Office desk.

Today the group continues with an "Open" meeting at the Unitarian Fellowship located at 1590 27th Avenue on Mondays at 7:00 pm.
