The Accessibilities assignment helps update service material to address barriers faced by some A.A. members to receive and/or carry the A.A. message. Some recent projects include the new Accessibility Resources Flyer and the update to the service piece "Making the A.A. Message Accessible" with sharing from neurodivergent members. This desk also helped produce ASL versions of the Big Book and "Twelve and Twelve," now available on our YouTube page and on aa.org. For members with vision loss, audio versions of the entire Big Book and "Twelve and Twelve" are available on aa.org, aa.org/accessibilities-workbook.

The Technology Services Department is always looking for ways to improve our ability to support the Fellowship, including: enhancing the contribution site to make it easier for groups and individual members

to contribute online; implementing new software to support meetings of the three Boards, the General Service Conference and the 2024 World Service Meeting; cybersecurity to protect member information; and, all the underlying technical architecture used across the office.

The A.A. Service Manual combined with the Twelve Concepts for World Service is Conference approved service material published by AAWS, it provides an overview of the service structure of the U.S. and Canada, for those who are new to service and old timers alike. It is updated every two years to better reflect the current landscape of local and general service.


