No Touching or Rubbing: Avoid touching or rubbing the treated areas for at least 6-12 hours after the filler injections. This helps prevent the filler from shifting or spreading.

Stay Upright: Maintain an upright position for the first few hours after the procedure. Avoid lying down or bending over during this time to prevent the filler from moving to unintended areas.

Avoid Strenuous Exercise: Refrain from strenuous physical activities, such as heavy lifting and vigorous exercise, for at least 24-48 hours post-injection. Excessive movement can cause the filler to settle unevenly.

Limit Alcohol and Blood Thinners: Avoid alcohol and blood-thinning medications for at least 24 hours after the procedure. These substances can increase the risk of bruising at the injection site.

Minimize Heat and Sun Exposure: Stay away from direct sunlight, hot tubs, saunas, and extreme heat for the first 24-48 hours post-injection. Heat can increase blood flow to the treated area and potentially affect the filler's placement.

Apply Cold Compresses: If swelling or bruising occurs, you can apply cold compresses to the treated areas. Use a clean cloth or ice pack wrapped in a thin towel for short intervals (10-15 minutes at a time).

Avoid Facials and Massages: Refrain from facials, facial massages, or any facial treatments for at least two weeks after the injection. These activities can disturb the filler's placement.

Stay Hydrated: Drink plenty of water to help your body recover and minimize swelling.

Patience is Key: Filler results may appear immediately but can also take a few days to settle. Allow time for the filler to integrate with your natural tissues and for any swelling to subside.

Report Adverse Effects: If you experience severe or unexpected side effects, such as excessive swelling, pain, or lumps, contact your healthcare provider promptly.

Long-Term Skin Care: After recovery, maintain good skincare practices, including sunscreen use and proper hydration, to prolong the results of your filler treatment.
