#### TRAIN RIDES

Take a train ride on a 1/3 size replica of the C.P. Huntington S.P. train that was built in 1863, through beautiful Beavers Bend Resort Park's Game Reserve. The train runs two times per hour, and the ride usually takes 15



minutes. Riders will sometimes spot some native wildlife, go up and down Wahoo Hill and run through a tunnel before pulling back into the station... don't forget your camera.




#### TRAIL RIDES

Trail rides are offered starting each hour. The ride will take you through 2 ½ miles of scenic Beavers Bend Resort Park's Game Reserve. Expect to see some of the native wildlife such as white tail deer, coyote, fox, squirrel, etc. The ride lasts approximately 45 minutes, but please allow at least an hour.

#### HAY RIDES

Hay rides are scheduled as available. Check with Beavers Bend Depot for times of departure. The hay rides last approximately 20-30 minutes. Private hay rides for families, organizations or any other groups may be arranged by calling the Depot at 580-494-6613.










# Planning to ride your OHV on the Quachita National Forest?

To make your trip more enjoyable, it is important to know where you may legally ride your 4-wheeler, motorcycle, or other ATV/OHV on the Ouachita National Forest in McCurtain County north of Broken Bow, Oklahoma. Changes to open routes may be made annually, so be sure to check with the Ouachita National Forest Visitor Office at the junction of Hwy 259 and Hwy 259A south to obtain a map and learn exact routes open for this use. Learn more by logging on to http://fs.usda.gov/ouachita.

#### Legal riding includes:

 Riding on open, unpaved forest roads that are depicted on the Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) available at the Ouachita National Forest Visitor Office on Hwy 259A south.

#### Illegal riding includes:

- · Riding out through the woods or across the forest floor
- Riding on powerline or pipeline right of ways, alongside the highway, or on any paved or unpaved road outside the boundary of the forest
- Riding in streams or rivers. Please cross at right angles and don't go "mudding" up and down streams or other muddy areas. Only cross where the road crosses the creek or river.
- Riding on any route not depicted on the Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) as an open route.

Have a great trip and understand that the rules and state laws are in place for a reason....protection of natural resources and human lives! Rules that may result in a fine if breached include:

- Riding on an undesignated route
- Operators or passengers under age 18 not wearing a helmet
- Carrying passengers on vehicles not manufactured for passengers



Fort Towson was established in 1824 as a frontier fort to guard the United States Southern border against Spanish invasion, from across the Red River. By the late 1820's, the frontier was pushing further westward. The fort was repurposed as the destination site of the Choctaw Indians during the westward removal of the Five Civilized Tribes, known today as the 'Trail of Tears. The fort was eventually abandoned by the government in 1854. During the Civil War, Confederate General Sam Bell Maxey used the fort as his headquarters.
