ARTISTS OF THE MONTH

Dale Hague

Dale creates art with clay and with paper, but mostly clay. Dale began clay art in the 1980s. He preferred making functional Art on a potter's wheel, but is currently using a stoneware clay that is mined just north of Roseville. He adds a small amount of ball clay and a bit less of bentonite to increase its plasticity. He has tweaked some old glaze formulas to better match the thermal expansion of this clay mixture and to take advantage of modern alternatives to troublesome ingredients.

His favorite functional form is the mug. He likes that a well-made mug is much more than just appearance, such as shape and color. It's also how it feels; the weight and balance, the size of the handle, the thickness of the lip. One of my clients told me, "I buy mugs from a lot of potters. I noticed yours are the one I use." Dale makes a lot of mugs, come to the Y-Bridge Cultural Arts Center this First Friday in June and try one.

Paula R. Lively is a Zanesville native. Her passion lies in her photography, and she's been doing it for over twenty years. 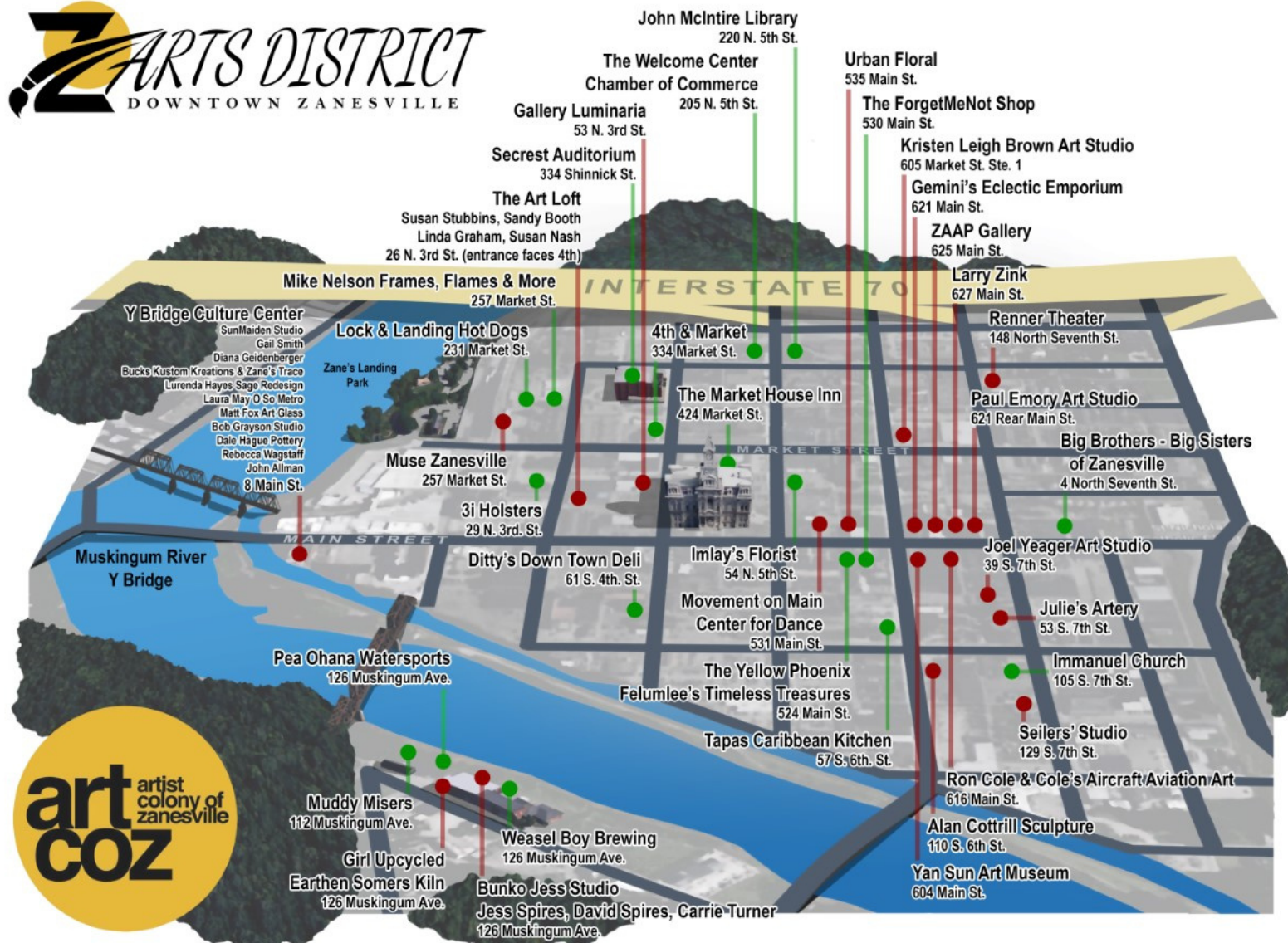

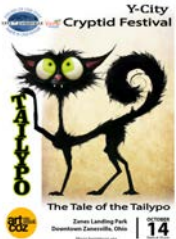
“Summer Celebration of Art”
