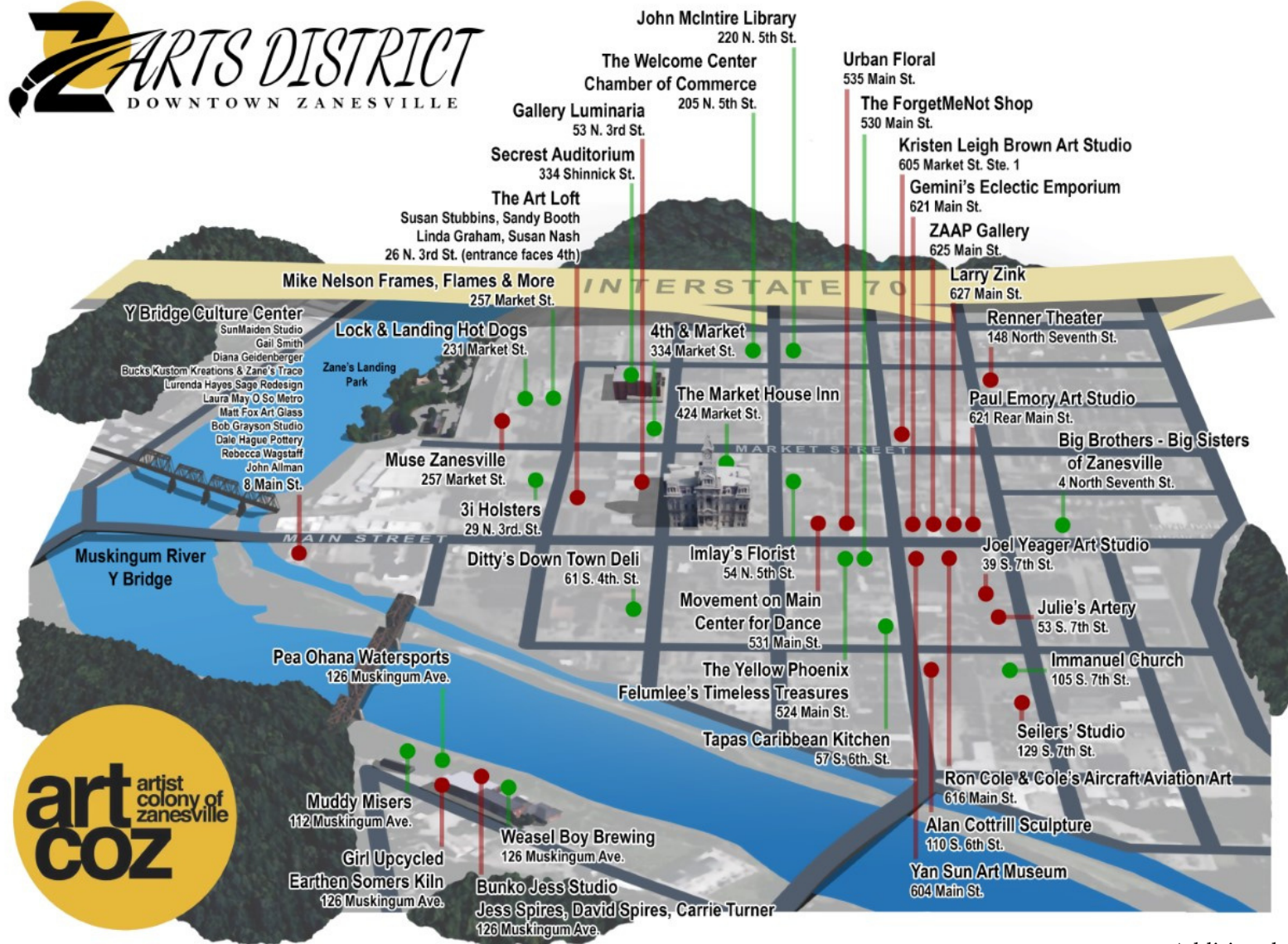

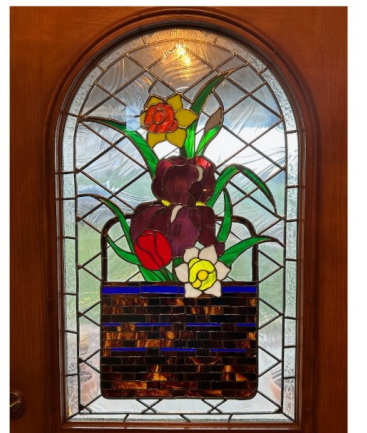


ARTIST OF THE MONTH

From the Vice President, Mark Goodall

Hello, I’m Mark Goodall – How may I help you today? You know the phrase “Jack of All Trades, but Master of None”? Essentially, that’s me. And I got it from my father and grandfather, whose names were both actually JACK Goodall. My grandfather taught shop classes at Adamsville school and my father taught me a great many things as I helped him run church camps growing up. Along the way, I’ve picked up a bachelor’s degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering, and a master's degree (MBA) in IT Management. I currently lead the IT team at Genesis Healthcare who manages the servers, networks, and other infrastructure. At this point, you’re probably wondering what qualifies me to help lead a group of artists. I mean, I’ve done some photography, and I restore brass band instruments, but I’m not gonna win any awards. The experience that I believe has prepared me to be of assistance to this group is as a “Jack of All Trades” partner to my wife, Julie Goodall, of Julie’s ARTery. In the 20+ years that she has been a self-employed art teacher, I have been her business manager, marketing advisor, IT guy, and construction worker. Speaking of construction, one of my latest contributions was to restore (with much help) a condemned and destroyed Victorian home on South 7th Street into the beautiful art studio/gallery/classrooms that Julie and her partner teachers currently teach from. In my new role as the Vice President of ArtCoz, I’d like to leverage the very wide variety of skills that I’ve learned so far and apply that to helping this group of artists move a little closer to their goals. I’ve tried to connect with as many of you as I can on Facebook, and would love it if you would request a connection if I haven’t found you yet. I want to share with you what I’m working on and celebrate what you’re working on. And don’t be surprised if I ask you at some point “how may I help you today?”



Jennifer Johnstonbaker was raised in Louisville, Ky, graduated from Indiana University after transferring from Western Ky University and Anderson College. Three of her instructors stand out as influences to her art: Sue Erwin, Miami University, Oxford; Rama Raol (painter, professor, India); and Richard Mantia, beloved by all his students. It was in 2019 that a solid “voice” emerged for the content relating to each painting in this show. The series depicts the future of our planet, her inhabitants, and space, with a dash of metaphoric spice. Inspiration typically comes from a worship setting with Jennifer sitting in a pew and not standing behind a lectern. “Someone else is speaking and I sketch the “inspired vision.” Opening: First Friday Art Walk 5-8pm and on display all month during regular gallery hours: Thur-Sun 1-5pm. This month’s window theme: “Mad as a March Hare” inspired by Alice in Wonderland
