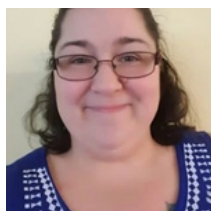
Shake off the winter blues in a colorful, welcoming studio space and explore artwork that inspires creativity and forward movement.

March Exhibition: "Twelve Years Together: Gallery Anniversary Exhibition"

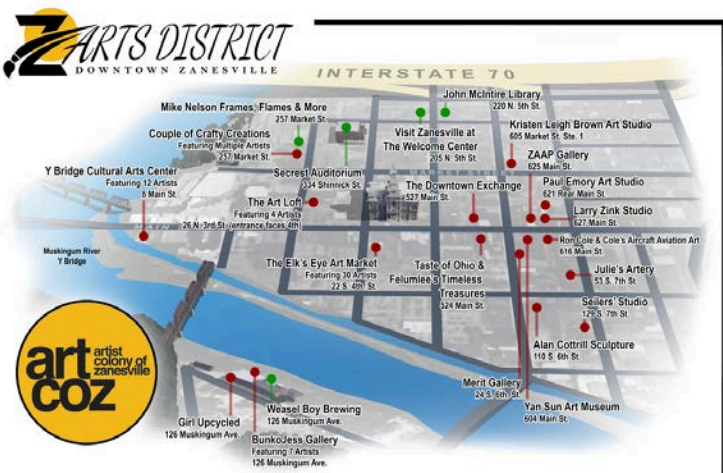

Robert A. Stonerock



Robert Stonerock's paintings are inspired by his farming roots and Pennsylvania Dutch heritage. Robert draws ideas from Pennsylvania Dutch festivals near Kutztown, PA and from artists Ivan Hoyt, Eric Claypoole, Andrew Shirk, Johnny Ott, and Johnny Claypoole. The barn stars he paints feature geometric patterns and motifs like tulips, distelfinks, hearts, birds, and flowers. Typically, barn stars are usually painted in four colors, symbolizing positivity such as love, good fortune, and abundance. Barn stars remain popular in Eastern Pennsylvania. Robert is largely self-taught but did study art in high school; his interest was rekindled at the local Veterans Affairs Clinic Art sessions. Robert's largest piece, a four-foot barn star, earned first place at the State Veterans Affairs Art Show.

Bill Baker III



Bill Baker is a local Ohio artist, who paints brilliant colors in acrylics and oils. Following his art studies at Newark High School, where he was awarded the Licking County Arts scholarship, he studied Architecture at Kent State, as well as Fine Arts at CCAD. With Best Of Show awards in Ohio and Florida, one favorite topic is lighthouses, having seen many during his U.S. Navy service. Birds, such as the Ohio Cardinal, captured his attention while roaming the hills of the Ohio Valley, his birthplace. Currently living locally on Buckeye Lake, he often paints memories of early morning fishing outings with his five Grandchildren. Clearly, his personal experiences guide Baker's work onto the canvas.
