Artist of the Month



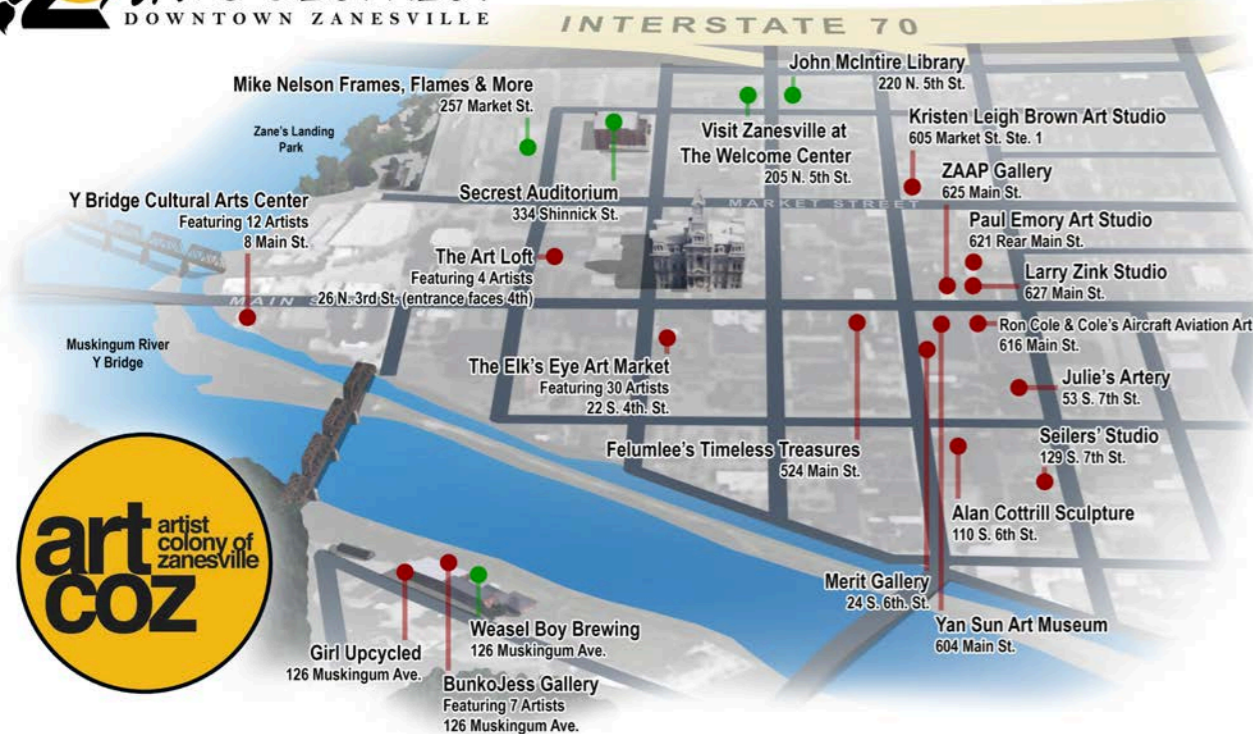
Danielle Parks is a long-time fixture of the Zanesville arts scene. Her artistic inspirations span the photographic to the decorative arts. Local families know her most through her photography business, Daniellabean Photography, where her passion for her clients is second to none. As a professional, Danielle takes skills developed over decades, spanning from Colorado to Spain, and she pours that dedication into transcending her client's images into artistic expression.

As anyone who knows her can attest, Danielle's art and personality are grounded in her love of the earth, nature, and the blessings we are graced in abundance. She has brought forth this appreciation artistically through her sculpture and painting. Harvesting ochre rocks from Black Hand Gorge, Danielle uses native pigments in expressive paintings. Crafting by hand, Danielle has learned to form and fire Ohio clay into delicate jewelry and miniature sculpture.

Danielle came by her artistic passion honestly, having been offered her first course in ceramics in 1996 at Tri-Valley High School. There, she discovered an unexpected love of art and physical expression. Her skills resulted in a position with the Longaberger Arts Department, where she worked while pursuing a college education in psychology and art. This education led her through years of educating preschoolers and children in art and life.

Danielle's current works have been inspired by her return to ceramics at Julie's Artery and are carried out at her home studio in downtown Zanesville. The growing and talented artist community endlessly inspires her in Muskingum County, and she is grateful to all who have believed in her work throughout her accomplished career.
