

Art classes with Mr. Simon were her favorite "extra" class of the week, and in third grade, Holly entered an impressionist piece into an art competition. Winning 3rd place, her piece was aired on a Pittsburgh news station, and she received tickets for a trip on the Gateway Clipper Fleet – pretty exciting for a 9-year-old!

In high school and college and while her kids were younger, Holly took a break from art, but in 2023, she decided to try something new. With her kids, Holly took a stained-glass workshop, taught by Bill Bird at Julie's ARTery. Bill has continued to support Holly's work in designing and making stained glass pieces from her home studio. Holly was surprised to win best in show with a stained glass farm at the Agriculture Show, hosted by BunkoJess, at the Muskingum County Blue Ribbon Fair last summer.

Wanting to learn more, Holly enrolled in several wheel throw pottery classes, taught by Julie Goodall at Julie's ARTery, and now leases studio space to continue creating. Holly appreciates Julie's willingness to share knowledge and to experiment with different clay and glazing techniques together. Holly also dances at the A2J Crew Dance Kompany in Zanesville.

Through her art and dance, Holly has been able to share interests and experiences with her kids, has made a lot of new friends, and has developed a deeper appreciation for lifelong learning and tapping into her creativity. At this stage of Holly's journey as an artist, she is focused on making a wide array of artwork while she finds her niche.
