

Paula Lively

Paula R. Lively, born and raised in Zanesville, Ohio, Paula R. Lively is a passionate and accomplished photographer with over 20 years of experience behind the lens. A graduate of The Art Institute of Pittsburgh, Paula specializes in photojournalism, capturing authentic moments through weddings, family portraits, newborn sessions, senior photos, special events, and volunteer engagements.

Paula is an active member of several professional and artistic organizations, including Professional Photographers of America, Professional Photographers of Ohio, Art CoZ, and the Zanesville Museum of Art.

Over the years, she has worked as a freelance photographer for a wide range of clients, including the Zanesville Times Recorder, A2J Dance Kompany, Rave and Dance Wear LLC, The New Bakery, D & R Studio LLC, and the rock band The GODZ. She also photographs for the City of Zanesville during the Secrest Summer Concert Series and was recently named the official photographer for the band Appalachian Outlaws. Paula's work has gained national attention, with her photography appearing on platforms such as CNN Travel (Las Vegas), PowWows.com, Wikimedia, Wikipedia, and even National Geographic. Locally, her images have been displayed at Applebee's in Zanesville and featured at the John and Annie Glenn Museum. She has contributed to several publications, including Superhuman Strength by Kelly Doudna, Resonate: Present Visual Stories That Transform Audiences by Nancy Duarte, and The International Library of Photography with a featured image titled "One Man's Story."

A strong advocate for community service, Paula has volunteered her talents for numerous organizations, including the American Red Cross and American Cancer Society of Muskingum County, the Animal Shelter of Muskingum County's Summer Jam, the Down Bikers Association, Girl Scouts Heart of Ohio, Perry Township and New Concord Fire Departments, and Buck Icon LLC – helping underprivileged youth attend football camps with the Ohio State Buckeyes.

Paula's achievements in the field have been recognized by the International Society of Photographers, who honored her with an award for Outstanding Achievement in Photography. She has also served in esteemed roles within Masonic organizations, including Grand Photographer for the Royal & Select Masons of Ohio (2010, 2022) and Grand Photojournalist for the Grand Chapter Royal Arch Masons of Ohio (2016). Most recently, she served as the official photographer for the Knights Templar of the Eastern Division of Ohio during the Wreath Laying Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery. She also documented the Easter Sunrise Service at the George Washington Masonic National Memorial in Alexandria, Virginia, and the officer installation of the Grand Council of Cryptic Masons of the State of New York. Paula has proudly photographed numerous Masonic events over the past two decades.
