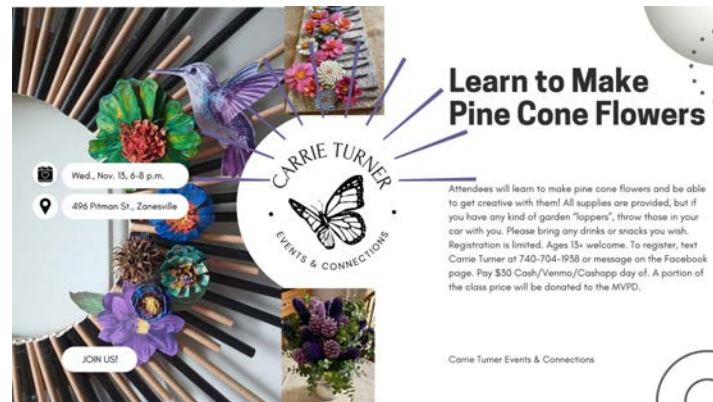


THE ARTS IN DOWNTOWN ZANESVILLE

Britni Ross

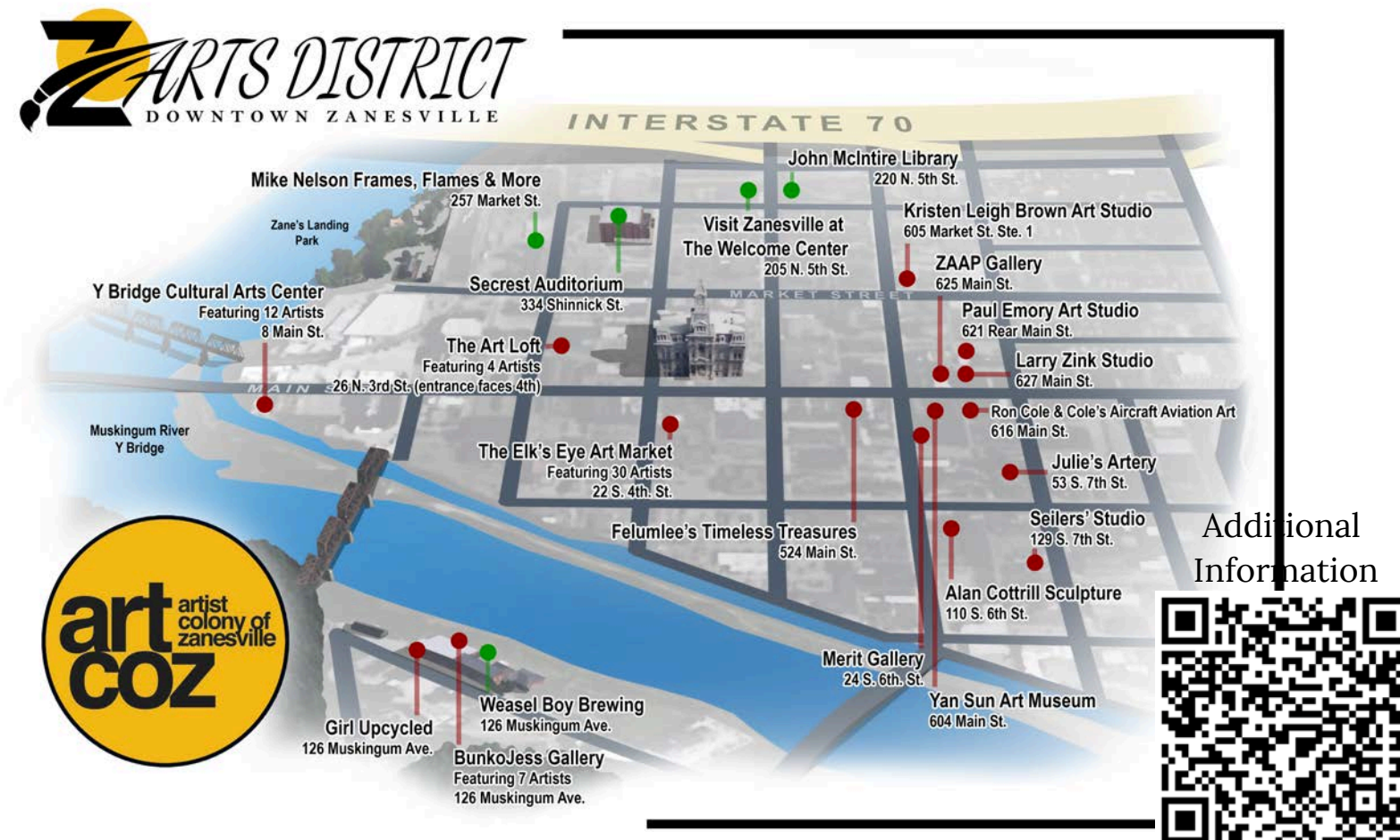
