After several teaching experiences in local museums, Misty developed a love for museum education, and currently serves as the education coordinator at the Zanesville Museum of Art, a post she has held since 2016. A studio potter in her spare time, Misty is proud of the rich pottery heritage of her hometown and surrounding areas, and loves playing a small role in keeping it alive.

Her body of work consists of a wide variety of vases, jars, mugs, and both decorative and functional dishes. She loves experimenting with new shapes, textures, and glaze combinations to make each piece a one-of-a-kind work of art.

Misty is one of several local artists with work on display at BunkoJess Gallery in downtown Zanesville. She has also been an exhibitor at the annual Y-bridge Arts Festival since 2022, winning an honorable mention award in 2024.
