Audition Procedures 2025-2026

All auditions are approximately 15 minutes in length and will consist of elements listed below.

Auditions must be completed by March 21, 2026, to be considered for a scholarship.

All students **MUST** audition for any ensemble.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO IN THE AUDITION?

Choral-Vocal Auditions provide the choral and voice faculty an opportunity to get to know you as a musician and person individually before the semester begins each year. As experienced musicians and educators, we know that many people are anxious about auditions, but we provide all our prospective students with a positive and supportive environment during your audition process.

AUDITIONS INCLUDE:

Performance:

- <u>NON-Music Major</u> Please select <u>**ONE**</u> of the pieces from the Audition Repertoire List. Sheet Music for each piece is also available for each voice part.
- <u>Music MINOR</u> Please select <u>ONE</u> of the pieces from the Audition Repertoire List. Sheet Music for each piece is also available for each voice part.
- <u>Music MAJOR</u> Please prepare <u>TWO</u> songs with the following guidelines:
 - (1) You may select from the Audition Repertoire List **OR** select a classical aria or art song for your voice type*.
 - *If you choose your own piece, please email a .pdf to msuchoir@msstate.edu.
 - (2) A selection of your own choosing (should be either a solo musical theatre piece, a solo spiritual, or another classically prepared solo.) *Please avoid any "popular" or "contemporary religious" selections.* Please email a .pdf copy of your sheet music to mschoir@msstate.edu.

Range Vocalization:

 Mississippi State University choral and voice faculty will vocalize you to determine your range.

Pitch Memory:

• You will sing back a series of pitches after they are played for you on the piano

Sight Singing:

You will sight-sing a melodic selection without accompaniment during your audition.

Interview:

• We will meet with you at the end of your vocal audition to get to know you better with a few questions about your interests and your background.

WHAT IF I AUDITION FOR A CERTAIN CHOIR AND I AM PLACED IN A DIFFERENT CHOIR?

It is important for you to be placed in a choir(s) that best matches your musical ability and vocal training.

WHERE ARE AUDITIONS?

Auditions are held in the new Music Building Choral Hall, 124 Hardy Road.

Your audition must be completed by March 21, 2026, to be considered for a scholarship.
