Dear Customer,

Mifflin County Municipal Authority (MCMA) is providing this notice to inform customers of a temporary interruption in the addition of Hydrofluorosilicic Acid (Fluoride) to the public drinking water supply beginning on or about April 13, 2026.

Fluoride is added to drinking water as a public health measure to help prevent tooth decay. Fluoride addition is not required for water safety. The drinking water continues to meet all state and federal primary drinking water standards and remains safe to drink.

This interruption is due to supply chain disruptions affecting the availability of fluoride treatment chemicals. MCMA is actively evaluating supply options and regulatory considerations and intends to resume fluoridation treatment once supply becomes available and operational conditions allow.

#### **Are there any health concerns?**

There are no adverse health effects associated with this temporary interruption. Customers concerned about dental health, including parents of young children, may wish to consult their dentist or healthcare provider regarding alternative sources of fluoride.

#### **What should I do?**

No action is required. Alternative water supplies are not necessary.
