Families & Generational Homes

- Paper equity, cash poor → forced sales
- Longer lifespans → assets run out, reliance on government
- \$10B+ spent on homelessness with limited results

Seniors, Disabled & Homelessness

- Seniors = fastest-growing homeless group
- No money to wildfire relief
- Losing multigenerational homes!

Schools & Teachers

- 41% of budget already goes to schools
- Prop19 drives teachers out of districts

Tenants & Affordable Housing

- Properties reassessed when landlords pass
- Inheritors raise rents or sell to developers
- Threatens NOAH (Naturally Occurring Affordable Housing)

Small Businesses

- Family-run shops face tax reassessments
- NN/NNN leases push costs onto tenants
- Thin margins → closures likely
