Download. Print on one side of an 8.5 X 11 white paper ONLY - back page must be empty. DO NOT alter the 1 inch MARGIN ON TOP in the printing settings - the officials need the 1 inch margin. Everything must be HANDWRITTEN in BLUE/BLACK ink only - NOT pre-filled electronically. Review how much space you have to answer so you don't run out of room. Write SLOWLY and LEGIBLY. There are 2 parts to this petition: The Signer Section and the Declaration of Circulator Section. Everything highlighted MUST BE FILLED, for the petition to be valid.

Signer #1 and Signer #2 must be **registered to vote** in write out the name in full of the County. (Signer #1 and #2 MUST LIVE IN THE SAME COUNTY. It is okay if the **Declaration of Circulator** lives in a different County.) Not sure which county, check → <a href="https://www.counties.org/cities-within-each-county">https://www.counties.org/cities-within-each-county</a>

\*Unsure of where you are registered or how you signed your name, check → <u>voterstatus.sos.ca.gov</u>
If eligible, register to vote online → <u>registertovote.ca.gov</u> and then you can sign this petition.
Any CA registered voter - even if you are living in another state or overseas can sign the petition and mail back.

**DECLARATION OF CIRCULATOR** (aka DC) is the same as being a witness. When you sign a petition you need someone to witness that you were the one who wrote on the petition. So either A or B:

## A- You can be a witness to yourself.

If you got this petition via text, email or from the internet, you'll download it. (Or someone leaves it at your house, mails it to or you pick up from somewhere.) In both cases you must read the Top Funders sheet, then you'll sign #1 or #2 AND you'll be your own DC.

For example, you and your spouse both have to be a registered CA voter, read Top Funder Sheet, sign #1 and #2. (If you make a mistake filling out, **DO NOT** cross out - just add to it for clarity. Or start over on a new petition. NO White-Out or correction tape.) **One of you MUST sign the DC.** 

## B- Or you can be a witness for signers #1 and #2.

For example, you go to a large sports event, and there is a person gathering signatures. They can be a paid DC or an unpaid/volunteer DC. They must be 18 years of age or older. They do NOT have to be a citizen or CA resident, registered voter nor live in the same county as #1 and #2. They will ask you what county you live in, show you the Top Funder Sheet and have you sign #1 or #2. **They will fill in the DC.** 

**DECLARATION OF CIRCULATOR:** print your name...18 years old...reside at residence address, include street and number, city, state, zip, has to be FILLED IN. Write the date you witnessed signer #1 and the last date you finished witnessing signer #2. (It is okay if you don't have a signer #2. It's okay if both of these dates are the same.)

You MUST show Top Funders sheet to signer #1 and #2.

If you have done all that then write: month, day of year at city, CA (This is the city that you are physically in when you finish filling out the DC. (It's okay if this date is not the same as the end date above.) Then sign your name. All this must be handwritten in blue/black pen only.

Every section of The Circulator Section must be completed. It's okay if you only have one signer #1 - you do NOT have to have #2 filled in, in order to mail to: HJTA1201 K Street, Suite 1030, Sacramento, CA 95814. If you have problems filling out please call a volunteer at 415 449-0980.
