The United Organization of Taxpayers Reclaim Voters' Rights lost in 2011 through SB202.

**Must be a CA registered voter to sign.** Check registration [voterstatus.sos.ca.gov](http://voterstatus.sos.ca.gov). If NOT, register now <https://registertovote.ca.gov/> then sign petition.

**Handwrite LEGIBLY** in black or blue ink. Stay WITHIN your box. **NO CROSS-OUTS.**

Start a new petition if you make a mistake. No other markings: highlighter, white out.

**DO NOT ABBREVIATE ANYWHERE.** Only exceptions: Sr., Jr., Apt., CA.

**STEP 3 Declaration of Circulator=DC** (witness statement) **EVERY FIELD** filled in to be valid.

**IF 1 person signing at home**, **handwrite your STEP 1 County.**

**STEP 2** Write your name, address, city, zip and signature.

**STEP 3** Write your name, address 2 times. The date 3 times.

**STEP 4** Sign again.

Petition is valid throughout campaign

**IF 2-3 persons signing at home**, **handwrite your STEP 1 County.**

**STEP 2** Each signer must **handwrite their own information.**

**STEP 3** One of you will write your name, address 2 times, the date 3 times and **STEP 4** sign again.

**IF 1, 2 or 3 persons signing anywhere**, **ALL** must live in the **SAME STEP 1 County.**

The person = Circulator who saw Signer 1, Signer 2 and Signer 3 sign, fills in **STEP 3**. The Circulator does NOT have to live in the same County as 1, 2 or 3. The date range they saw them sign. Place of Signing = wherever they are physically when they finish the DC use that address (it's simpler to finish this in their home)(OK if they need to write the overflow address below that) and **STEP 4** sign.

**The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:**

(25-0019A1.) REPEALS STATE LAW THAT PROHIBITS BALLOT INITIATIVES AND REFERENDA FROM BEING SUBMITTED TO VOTERS AT PRIMARY ELECTIONS. INITIATIVE STATUTE. Under current law, as amended by the Legislature in 2011, statewide ballot initiatives and referenda can only be submitted to voters at the statewide general election held in November of even-numbered years, or at a statewide special election. This measure repeals the 2011 law to allow statewide initiatives and referenda to be submitted to voters at any statewide election, including primary elections and general elections held in November of an odd-numbered year. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: Likely increased costs to state and local governments, possibly up to the low tens of millions of dollars each statewide election cycle. The extent of the increased costs would depend on whether more citizen initiatives qualify for the ballot. (25-0019A1.)

**INITIATIVE MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO THE VOTERS**

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure: (25-0019A1.) REPEALS STATE LAW THAT PROHIBITS BALLOT INITIATIVES AND REFERENDA FROM BEING SUBMITTED TO VOTERS AT PRIMARY ELECTIONS. INITIATIVE STATUTE. Under current law, as amended by the Legislature in 2011, statewide ballot initiatives and referenda can only be submitted to voters at the statewide general election held in November of even-numbered years, or at a statewide special election. This measure repeals the 2011 law to allow statewide initiatives and referenda to be submitted to voters at any statewide election, including primary elections and general elections held in November of an odd-numbered year. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: Likely increased costs to state and local governments, possibly up to the low tens of millions of dollars each statewide election cycle. The extent of the increased costs would depend on whether more citizen initiatives qualify for the ballot. (25-0019A1.)

**TO THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

We, the undersigned, registered, qualified voters of California, residents of \_\_\_\_\_ County, hereby propose amendments to the Elections Code, relating to elections, and petition the Secretary of State to submit the same to the voters of California for their adoption or rejection at the next succeeding general election or at any special statewide election held prior to that general election or as otherwise provided by law. The proposed statutory amendments read as follows:

**Reclaim Voters' Rights Act**

SECTION 1. (a) This act shall be known, and may be cited, as the Reclaim Voters' Rights Act.

(b) In 2011, Californians lost the right to vote on citizen-initiated ballot measures at statewide primary elections. This act restores that right.

SEC. 2. Section 9016 of the Elections Code is amended to read:

9016.(a) Notwithstanding Section 324, for purposes of subdivision (c) of Section 8 of, and subdivision (c) of Section 9 of, Article II of the California Constitution, "general election" means only the election held throughout the state on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year with respect to an initiative or referendum measure that is certified for the ballot on or after July 1, 2011.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an initiative measure shall not be submitted to the voters at placed on a statewide special election held ballot that qualifies less than 131 days after the date the measure is certified for the ballot before the date of the election.

(PU Amended by Stats.2011, Ch. 558, Sec. 1. (SB 202) Effective January 1, 2012.)

SEC. 3. Only the voters may amend these sections.
