

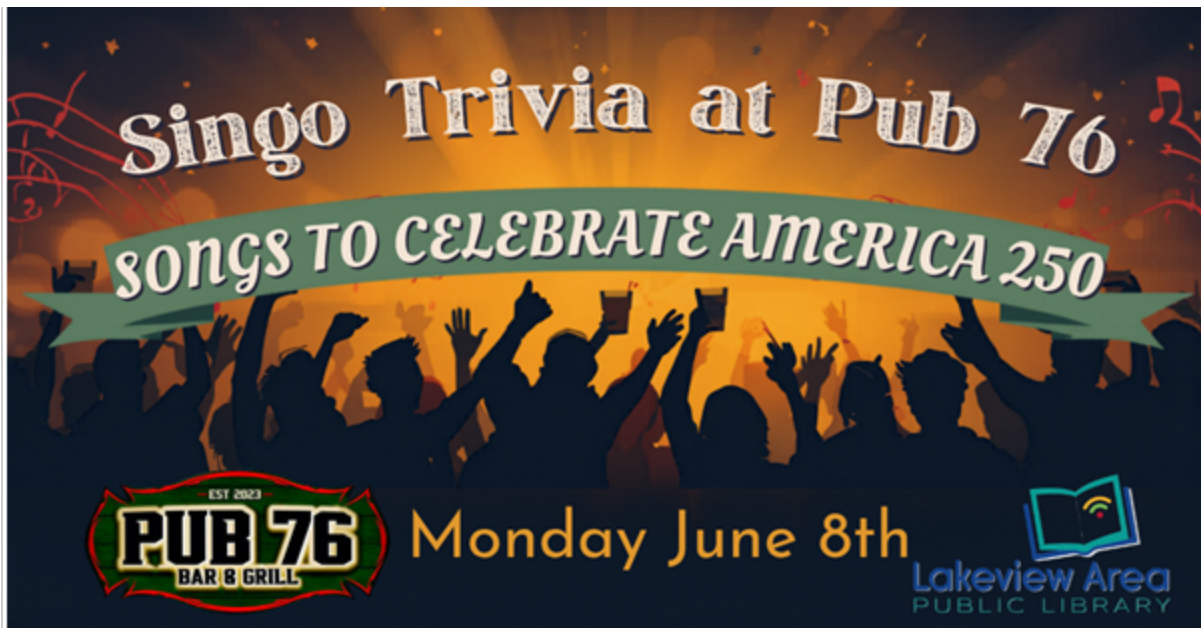


Lakeview Library June Newsletter

Construction Site: Firefight!

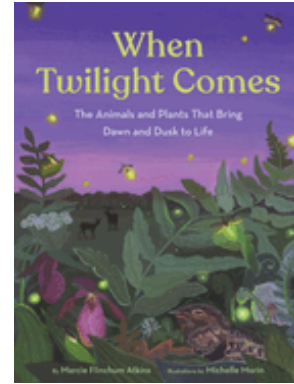
