## We are moving to a Fine Free, Fee-based System

Our library provides newly published and old favorites that our patrons love! We want to keep these materials circulating and available, while reducing the stress of overdue fines, keeping the reading experience enjoyable for all. In an effort to meet these goals, we have implemented a Fee Based Borrowing Policy. No daily fines will be charged, but fees will be charged for lost or damaged materials.

### How Does It Work?

Checkout period remains 3 weeks, but with only 1 renewal.

Materials not returned by the end of the 2nd renewal will be billed for the replacement cost of the material.

There will be a limited time to reimburse the library for these materials

.Due date reminders will be emailed to members, but no fines charged.
