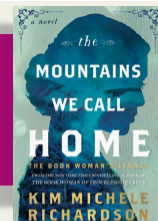
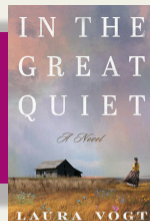

If you have been corresponding, but didn't receive a reply, please be patient as there were some mail mix ups over the holidays and we're getting things back in order currently. Thank you!

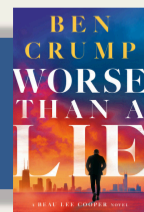
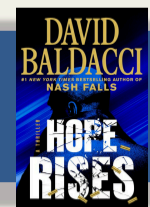
