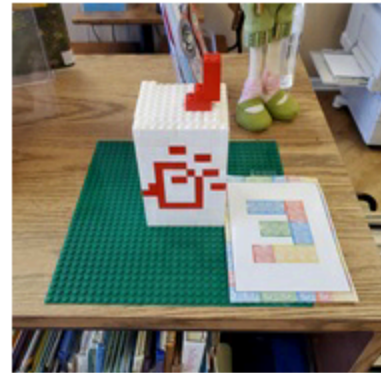

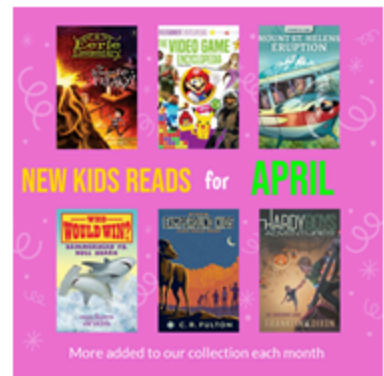
Book Club
