Earn an agility title on your beginner dog in a trial-like atmosphere. The Agility Course Test is an AKC entry-level agility event designed to introduce beginning dogs and/or handlers to the sport of agility. Dogs must be at least 15 months old to enter, and they must meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Regulations, Ch 1, Section 3), except that they need not be AKC registered to enter.

<u>ACT 1</u> is open to all dogs who have not earned any AKC agility titles. The course will have 10-12 obstacles including a 5' A-frame, table, tunnel, and bar jumps (no spread jumps). Tire and panel jump are allowed but not required. Time for the course will be 60 seconds, and a minimum score of 85 is required to earn a qualifying run.

<u>ACT 2</u> is open to all dogs who have not earned any AKC agility titles except for an ACT 1 title. The course will have 11-13 obstacles. All ACT 1 obstacles will be used with the addition of a teeter, tire, 1 spread jump, and 6 weaves. Time for the course will be 70 seconds, and a minimum score of 85 is required to earn a qualifying run.

<u>Refusals and Run-outs</u> will not be judged. More than 3 attempts on any obstacle will result in an elimination/failure to perform. Table faults, wrong courses, and failures to perform will be judged the same as at a regular AKC agility trial. Two qualifying runs are needed for a title in each class, and both titles can be earned under the same judge.

<u>Jump heights</u> are at the handler's discretion. Jump Heights are 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, and 24 inches. A jump height card and/or measurement are not required.

<u>Entry fee</u> is \$22 per run (including \$5 AKC recording fee). Maximum number of runs per dog is 4 (1 run per each round), and the entry limit is 80 runs. Day of show entries may be accepted if the entry limit has not been reached after the event closing date. <u>Please mail your entry and entry fee to Windle Ewing</u>, 4212 Nasmyth Drive, Plano, TX 75093.

Event will be held inside the training barn at Best Friends Fun Farm. The surface will be dirt.

Check-in will begin at 8:30AM. Please do not arrive at Best Friends prior to 8:00AM.

Initial Briefing will be held at 9:00AM. An additional briefing may be held prior to Act 2, Round 1.

Walk-throughs will be allowed prior to each round.

Judging will commence at 9:30AM.

<u>Judging Schedule</u> will be ACT 1, Round 1, followed by ACT 1, Round 2, followed by ACT 2, Round 1, followed by ACT 2, Round 2.

<u>Running Order</u> will be small (4") to tall (24") for all rounds. A listing of the running order will be <u>emailed</u> prior to the event. If day of show entries are allowed, these dogs will run at the end of each jump height per each round.

<u>Title Certificates</u> will be provided by the AKC for all registered dogs who earn their ACT 1 and/or ACT 2 titles. Dogs who earn a qualifying run will receive a green qualifying ribbon.

<u>Dogs not registered with AKC</u> are eligible to participate, and their performances will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. Entries will be accepted as received. Your entry must be complete and signed to be accepted. No phone, email, or fax entries will be accepted. Entry fees must be submitted with your entry. Returned checks will not constitute a valid entry, and a \$30 charge will be assessed in addition to the entry fee if you incur a returned check. There will be no refunds if your dog is absent, excused, and/or barred from this event. Refunds will be given for bitches in season upon inspection and/or receipt of a confirming letter from a veterinarian.

<u>Crate</u> your dog inside your vehicle or set up a crate for you dog on the grass beside the outside training field. Crating will not be allowed inside the barn or within the outside training field. The outside training field will be closed during this event.

**Exercise** your dog on any grassy area except for the outside training field. Please pick up after your dog.

<u>Dogs must be on leash</u> at all times except when performing in the training barn. When it is your turn to run, enter the barn with your dog on leash, and make certain you leash your dog before exiting the barn. Flexi leashes are not allowed at any time while on the property. Dogs may perform while wearing a flat buckle or rolled leather collar. Please remember to remove all tags from your dog's collar if you choose to use one. Dogs may also run without a collar if you choose to do so. Please consult the AKC's Agility Regulations if you have any questions regarding acceptable leashes and/or collars.

<u>Parking</u> for this event is in the gravel lot adjacent to the outside training field. Please do not park on the grass or along the drive beside the outside training field.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. #### INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT 1 or ACT 2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered-listed with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine Partners**<sup>SM</sup> applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered-listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC NO. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their AKC Junior Handler Number on this form. If you have yet to obtain your Junior Handler number, you can do so by contacting the American Kennel Club at (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on this form, please list the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner under **Handler**.
