Appliance Re-Calls

There are some very serious appliance recalls that can result in overheating and fire if not detected and remedied. We will be starting a new section on our website and also in our upcoming Newsletters, notifying members.

Maintaining Your Garbage Disposal

Clogged Garbage Disposal – YUCK!

Some Do's and Don'ts to prevent it:

Do

- 1. Use Cold Water: Always run cold water while using the garbage disposal. It helps in solidifying any fats or oils, making them easier to chop up and wash away.
- 2. Grind Small Amounts: Feed small portions of food waste into the disposal to avoid overwhelming it and ensure efficient grinding.
- 3. Keep it clean You can grind fibrous vegetables like celery, carrots, or small amounts of ice to help clean the disposal.

Don't:

- 1. Put in Non-Food Items: Avoid putting non-food items like glass, plastic, metal, or paper into the disposal, as these can **damage** the blades and motor.
- 2. Put too much food waste in the garbage disposal at once. This can overload the blades and cause them to clog.
- 3. run the garbage disposal without water. Just can overheat the blades and damage the garbage disposal.

- 4. Toss Large Bones: Large, hard bones should not be put in the disposal as they can damage the blades.
- 4. Dispose of Stringy Foods: Foods like corn husks, onion skins, or pasta can get tangled in the disposal, so avoid putting them in.
- 5. Grind Hard Objects: Avoid grinding hard objects like large seeds or pits, as these can damage the disposal's grinding mechanism.

If you have a clog

To unclog a garbage disposal, you can try the following methods:

- 1. Turn off the power to the Garbage Disposal
- Inspect the disposal to see what is causing the clog. You can use a flashlight to look inside the disposal opening. If you see a large object, you can try to remove it with needle-nose pliers Tongs but never use your fingers.
- 3. Use baking soda and vinegar to dissolve the clog. Pour 1/2 cup of baking soda into the disposal, followed by 1 cup of vinegar. Let the mixture fizz for 15-20 minutes, then flush the disposal with hot water.
- 4. If all else fails, call KPW
