6. You must have your meal ticket to enter the lunch or dinner area during the meal. You may come to the Dinner area after 9:00 P.M. for the awards and door prizes.

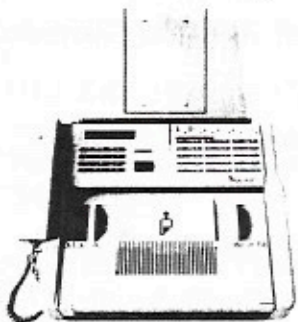

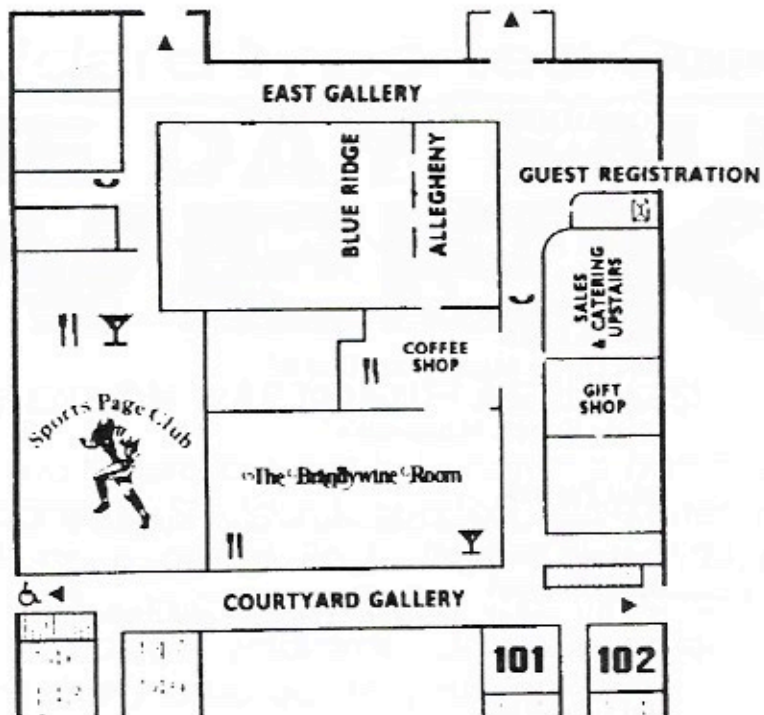
