Greek Meatballs with Lemon Dill Rice

Ingredients

For the meatballs:

1 1/4 pounds ground beef

1/4 cup breadcrumbs

1 teaspoon dried oregano

1/2 teaspoon lemon zest

1 clove garlic minced

1 egg

1 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

Remainder ingredients:

1 tablespoon olive oil

1 1/2 cups Village Harvest Arborio Rice

3 1/2 cups chicken broth

kosher salt and pepper to taste

2 zucchini quartered lengthwise and cut into 1/2 inch thick slices

1/2 cup cherry tomatoes halved

1/4 cup fresh dill minced

1 tablespoon lemon juice


Instructions


- 1. For the meatballs: Combine all the ingredients along with 1 tablespoon of water in a bowl. Mix until thoroughly combined. Shape the meat mixture into balls that are 2-3 inches in diameter.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.
- 3. Heat the olive oil in a large skillet

By Laura Swope over high heat. Place the meatballs in the pan and cook for 3-4 minutes on

each side or until browned.

- 4. Pour the chicken broth and rice into the pan, along with 1/2 teaspoon of kosher salt and 1/4 teaspoon black pepper. Bring the mixture to a boil, cover the pan and place it in the oven.
- 5. Bake for 25 minutes or until the rice has absorbed all the liquid.
- 6. Place the zucchini into the pan, cover and return to the oven for an additional 5 minutes or until zucchini has cooked through.
- 7. Remove the pan from the oven. Stir the lemon juice and dill into the rice and place the cherry tomatoes on top. Serve immediately.












