INGREDIENTS

4 eggs

1 cup flour

2 cups milk

1 tablespoon sugar

1/8 teaspoon salt


DIRECTIONS

Mix all of the ingredients well. Pour a scant 1/4 cup of the batter onto a hot skillet. Cook turning once. Put on plate and then sprinkle with sugar. My daughter likes to spread preserves at this point, but I just pour on more sugar. Roll it up like a little burrito and then pour more sugar on the top of the rolled crepe. In my house you can't cook these fast enough so it is a good idea to maybe have a couple skillets going at the same time. This makes a lot but I guarantee you won't have any left over!


