

KHRI KH about a year without a place to run our monthly local autocross. With the help of one of our board members, we were able to find a new and exciting place to have and hold our autocross events. We have started using the new Edmond facility in September 2017. With the start to a new year and the beginning of the partnership we've been able to secure the Edmond Fire Department. I would like to take a moment to review some of the differences between the new facility and the Sheriff's track, our old facility.

Apart from the new location being in Edmond rather than the middle of Oklahoma City, the most notable difference with the new track is the construction where concrete was used instead of asphalt. It also has a mountable style curb, which will help prevent excessive damage if you go up and over it. Instead of hitting a barrier style curb that could cause damage to your car, you have a curb that is sloped to allow you to more easily roll over the curb. Another difference between the two locations is the amount of run off room that the drivers have access to. The Edmond track has been set up with safety and technical skill in mind.

However there will be minimal run off room which should enhance the drivers' skills and abilities to recognize and be aware of the limitations of their vehicles.

Both facilities have been very accommodating to our organization and myself in an infinite amount of ways that are too numerous for me to list here. They are always willing to help make our track events and experiences better for everyone who attends. Again, we are excited to have another year of Autocross events. I would like for everyone to attend at least one event this year.


