Enjoy your Porsche !

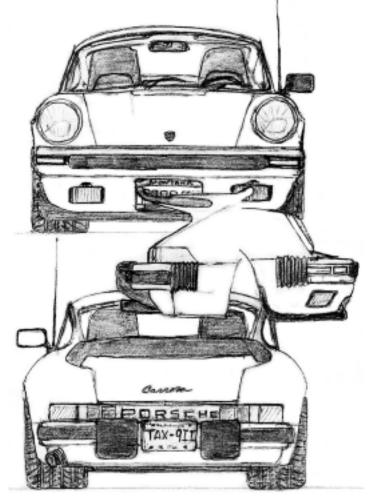



NAME ello all, it's time to update **NAME** you on our progress to have autocross events. We are ecstatic to report that our first autocross in over a year took place this past September.

We had a great turnout for the restart of the autocross events. Plus, there will be some upcoming changes to the next two autocross events. With that being said, we are glad to be back up and running. We hope to continue events similar to this first event until we can get back to the Sheriff's Training Center course.

On Saturday the 9th of September, the War Bonnet Region had their first autocross in over a year. I can say that we had a great turn out with around 25 drivers. All of the participants were PCA Members. I would also like to extend a 'thank you' to the four drivers who came down from the Tulsa Cimarron region to participate in our autocross event.

Cimarron's autocross event took place the following day and we had a few War Bonnet drivers take the trip to participate in that event as well.

Following the completion of the first War Bonnet autocross event of the year, we are pleased to announce that we will have two more events that will take

place before the end of the current calendar year. This will be followed by a break until we restart the autocross events in May of 2018.

We plan to open the next two events this year to both PCA and Non-PCA members. We will be capping registration to the first 40 drivers that show up to the event and don't have their vehicle disqualified from being able to participate.

Two drivers sharing the same vehicle will be counted as 2 against the total and not 1 because they are sharing a vehicle. PCA Members will have the first open slots. All non PCA member attendees will be allowed to register on a first come, first serve basis following the PCA members signup.

I would like to conclude by thanking all the members from both the War Bonnet Region and the Cimarron Region for coming out to our autocross. I hope to see this same group come back for the next two events this year. I hope that we don't have to turn anyone away from the next two events but I would like to see as close to 40 participants as we can get. We would like to see some of the old non-members show up for the next two events as well as some new nonmembers from around the area. This track is a nice track but I personally miss the Sherrif's Training center track since it offers a better variety of event layouts.



Treasurer's Tid-Bits

he club treasury received a nice infusion of money from PCA national. The regular quarterly rebate was \$883, and we also received a special rebate for the charity car show of an additional \$450 for the Sunbeam Family Services car show held at the Devon Boathouse.

For the car show we took in a grandtotal of \$739. It is a strange number because several members donated some extra cash for the charity. All the proceeds for the car show will be donated to the Sunbeam Family Services.

The site rental cost was split with the Mercedes club, and the Boathouse foundation discounted the cost since we were doing a charity event. In the end, our half of the cost was \$375.

We did not print t-shirts and we did not have a food truck or other items that have eaten into the profits as in the past. I have not yet heard what income the Mercedes club received. I do know the Mercedes dealer donated \$5,000 directly to Sunbeam because of the car show.

The Mercedes club has more members than War Bonnet region, and they had a few more cars participate. We split the car show, and they take care of their part, and we do our part but we each

take care of the money made for the car show and the donation to Sunbeam.


The local Porsche dealer did support us this year by bringing out 4 brand new cars for the display, and they had some employees on site to answer questions. We really appreciate the support from Porsche of Oklahoma City and all the members that showed up in their Porsches to help make the show bigger and better than in the past.

We also took in money from an autocross. Yeah, the autocross is back! The track cost us \$200 to rent, and we have to hire an Edmond Police officer to provide security. The officer costs us an additional \$150, so just putting on the autocross now has a base cost of \$350. We took in \$480 so we did make a profit.

I want to thank Steve Pistole for his hard work in finding us a new place to play, and Matt Herndon for putting on another fun autocross.

The club treasury also had the normal costs of the War Whoop mailing to national officers, and the members who prefer to receive a paper copy. In the

end, the treasury is up to a little over \$6,500 but we will be making a donation to Sunbeam Family services fairly soon. The board of directors decides the amount of the donation. With the money from PCA national and the income from the event, we raised about \$814. We plan to give all of that to the charity and will likely add in some club money to make it a nice round number.



Roster Report

e currently have 204 primary members in our region. This is the first time that I can remember that we have ever had over 200 primary members. It seemed for many years we were stuck at around 180-185 and rarely got over 190. Now we are holding steading at over 200! Our total membership including affiliate members is now 310.
