President's Podium

The following is the September mid-month membership update. First and foremost, I hope everyone is safe and healthy.

While these are difficult times for many of us, I wanted to share some positive membership stats:

August ended with 87,280 total primary members, up 418 from July end of month. Membership growth continues. This shows people are looking for something positive in their lives despite these challenging times ... and PCA delivers! Here's some notes:

- Primary membership now exceeded 2020 starting point. Back to positive growth for 2020.
- Membership drops were lower than last August (1,514)
- New member joins exceeded prior August (1,092)
- Late renewals remain strong (840)
- New record for Test Drive (905)

- August averaged 35.22 new members per day (34.96 new members per day in August 2019)
- Member referrals remain strong in August (325)
- 430 new members from marketing efforts in August

The War Bonnet Gourmet

Tomato Hamburger Veggie Soup

Ingredients

1 lb lean ground beef

1 small onion, finely diced

2 cloves garlic, minced or pressed

1 teaspoon salt

2 cups peeled and chopped potatoes (I always use Yukon Gold)

2 cans (14.5 oz each) beef broth

1 can (10 oz) condensed tomato soup

1 can (15 oz) petite diced tomatoes, undrained

1 bag (16 oz) frozen mixed vegetables

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1 teaspoon dried parsley 1/2 teaspoon dried basil salt & pepper, to taste


Instructions

- 1. In a soup pot, over mediumhigh heat, brown the ground beef, onion, garlic, and salt until no longer pink. Break up meat in crumbles as it cooks. Drain and return to the soup pot.
- 2. Add chopped potatoes, beef broth, tomato soup, diced tomatoes, frozen vegetables, Worcestershire sauce, and the seasonings. Stir to combine. Bring to a boil. Once boiling, cover with a lid and reduce hear to medium-low. Let simmer for at least 30 minutes for the flavors to combine and the soup to become thicker.




