

SITE ACCESS MEDICAL SCREENING DURING SEVERE WEATHER

This information share will focus on raising awareness of actions taken with regards to site access medical screening during severe weather warnings. During this time the following guidance shall be followed:

Lightning Warning

1. Site access medical screenings will be halted immediately.
2. HealthWorks employees and visitors shall relocate to C-104 north entrance.
3. Protective Force will limit pre-screenings through Gate 2 to one person/vehicle at a time.
 - a. Lanes 3, 4, & 5 will be shut down (Red lights activated);
 - b. Lanes 3, 4, & 5 will be blocked by cones and flashers, if safe to do so.
 - c. Inbound traffic will be directed to Lane 2.
4. Via microphone/speaker at entry post, Protective Force will direct employee to go to the back of C-104 and park at the back door entrance.
5. Employee enters the back of the building (approximately 10 feet away) where Health Works will perform their site access medical screening.
6. Once complete, the employee will go back to their vehicle and continue on to their assigned work area.
7. Protective Force then releases the next car to go to the parking area behind C-104 for site access medical screening.

Severe Thunderstorm Warning

1. Site access medical screenings will be halted immediately.
2. HealthWorks employees and visitors shall seek shelter in the C-104 facility.
3. DUF6 employees should process through gate and relocate immediately to the C-1100 break room.
4. Employees are to remain in the breakroom until a site access medical screening is completed by a medical services provider. Face coverings and social distancing guidelines should be followed to the extent practical

Tornado Warning

1. Site access medical screenings will be halted immediately.
2. HealthWorks employees and visitors shall seek shelter in the C-104 facility.
3. DUF6 employees should process through gate and relocate immediately to the C-1100 Trailer Complex tornado shelters.
4. Employees are to remain in the tornado shelter until a site access medical screening is completed by a medical services provider. Face coverings and social distancing guidelines should be followed to the extent practical
