Good afternoon. Today marks a milestone in your response to resuming Phase 1 work activities at the Portsmouth and Paducah sites during the COVD-19 pandemic. I want to congratulate and thank you for your diligence in protecting your co-workers as you restarted projects, and maintained an outstanding safety posture at both the Portsmouth and Paducah sites. Your commitment to enhanced safety and deliberate restart of planned project activities has paved the way for moving to Phase 2 of our approach to returning the site to routine operations.

PPPO has been authorized to begin Phase 2 activities. This will be a slow ramp up as we continue to monitor impacts of COVID-19 on the surrounding area and within PPPO's workforce.
