Description: On Thursday, December 8, 2016, the City of Riverside Fire Department

responded to and extinguished a fire in a single apartment unit on the 10th floor in the city's second tallest high-rise building which is a senior citizen residential complex. This is the building's second major fire since 1993 with the fire in 1993 having one civilian fatality. The fire destroyed the entire 10th floor from fire, heat, smoke, and water damage in a 16-story building. The fire injured two residents, there were no firefighter injuries nor any fatalities and resulted in a 1-million-dollar loss with an overall 16 million

dollar save.

Lessons learned will be discussed along with the fire department's response and mitigation of the incident. Helmet camera footage of arrival on scene,

fire attack and rescue of the victim will be shown in class.
