It's the first step in formal EFCT training, opening the door to advanced practice and certification, enhancing therapists' efficacy and confidence in their clinical work with couples.

- Understand basic experiential and systemic concepts of Emotionally Focused therapy.
- View clients within their interpersonal attachments to conceptualize relationship distress and repair.
- Develop skills for maintaining an engaged, collaborative alliance with clients.
- Learn the five moves of the EFT Tango to change affect regulation and interaction patterns.
- Acquire skills in EFT micro-interventions from experiential and attachment models.

WHO IS THIS TRAINING FOR?

All mental health professionals including psychiatrists, psychologists, family physicians, social workers, psychiatric nurses, counsellors (including couples and family therapists), pastors and clergy, and students training in these professions. School counsellors and occupational therapists are permitted to attend if they are licensed and belong to a professional body that has standards of practice for psychotherapy/ counselling.

Life coaches are not permitted to attend unless they also meet one of the mental health professional categories listed above.

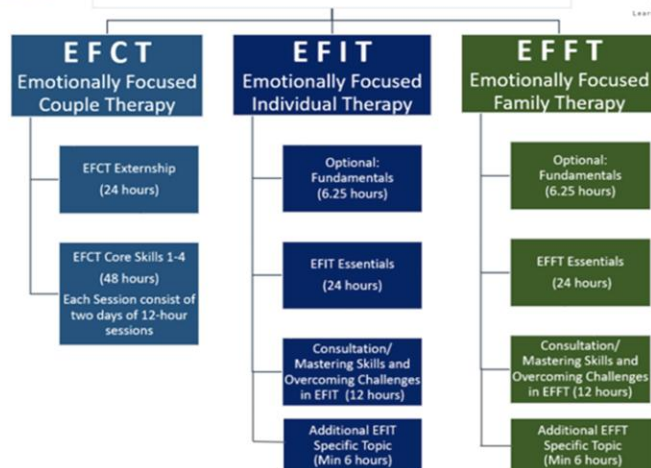
SGEFT Scholarship Eligibility Requirement:
