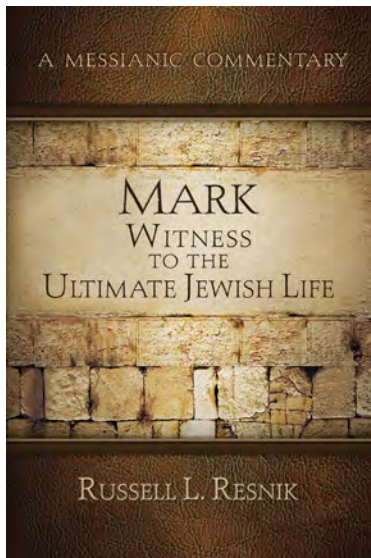
The King with a Listening Heart
