A volume that confirms Catholics in the faith and invites unbelievers to reflect on their skepticism.

In *He Suffered under Pontius Pilate*, Messori's historical analysis focuses on the last (but decisive) part of Jesus' condemnation, passion, and death on the cross. The author is a believer, but his research is not guided by religious convictions, but by irrefutable documents and by the decipherment of every Gospel word.

With the clarity of a journalist, combined with the preparation of an expert, the author closes with this book the trilogy in which he demonstrates the historicity of the life and message of Jesus, while at the same time proposing an original key to interpretation, both modern and scientific, for reading and understanding the Gospels.

When Messori published his first book, *Hypothesis on Jesus*, which became a worldwide bestseller, many urged him to also write "Hypotheses About Mary". The proposal was accepted almost 30 years later in 2005, and it also became a worldwide bestseller. The result is lively and "colorful": Dogma joins anecdote, biblical exegesis with apparitions, spirituality with history, theology with mystery. Each of the sixty chapters can be read alone or as a whole. Judges tells the story of what happens when God's people are blessed. Often (as Moses warned them), Israel forgets who gave them the land. They go after other gods – the defeated idols of the countries they had conquered. The good news in this discouraging cycle of disobedience is that the Lord does not abandon his people. When we return, he saves.

Ruth tells a smaller story. While Joshua and Judges speak of rulers and nations, Ruth tells of an Israelite woman, Naomi, and her Moabite daughter-in-law, Ruth, who is faithful to Naomi. God is the hero of the story of Ruth, even though his name is rarely mentioned. The Lord works through the lives of those the world considers little people to bless the entire world.

After the initial conquest of key cities, such as Yericho (Jericho), the Land is divided among Israel's tribes, with each tribe responsible for conquering their own area. 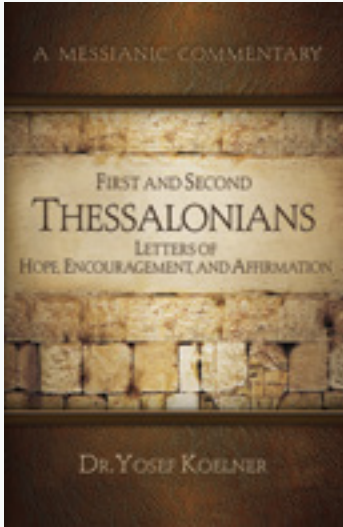

"Providence" is the gracious outworking of God's sovereignty, one in which all events are directed, permitted, or disposed by God, so as to work out his will and his plan for all this world and for all its times. It is important, however, that we distinguish between God's General Providence and his Special Providence. In his use of General Providence, God shows his ruling over the universe through his use of general rules that operate according to the created rules of nature, without needing specific or special acts of direct divine intervention of his will in a special way in every case. In his Special Providence, on the contrary, God manifests his working in direct response to special situations, or particular persons, using aspects of his work usually not seen in the laws of creation.
