Fremont River Deck Frequently Asked Questions



- How many guests can you accommodate? Our hall can comfortably accommodate up to 250 for a seated dinner.
- Do you offer in-house catering? • We do not. You're welcome to bring your own food or hire a caterer. Food service is the responsibility of the chosen caterer.
- If we provide our own caterer, is there a kitchen and/or storage/prep area for • them to use? Yes! We have a prep kitchen with an upper & lower alto sham, stand up cooler, prep counter & a dishwasher.
- Are tables, chairs, linens, plates, glassware, and silverware included? What is the • cost breakdown? Tables & chairs for reception are included in your wedding package.

Linens: -White/black, straight/round: \$10/tablecloth

Place Settings: > Includes dinner plate, water glass, and silverware -50 place setting: \$100.00 -100 place setting: \$150.00 -150 please setting: \$200.00

White Ceremony Chairs: -You set up: \$1.00/chair -We set up: \$2.00/chair

White Chair Covers: -You put on: \$1.00 -We put on: \$2.00

- Can we bring in our own cake/desserts? Yes! It doesn't have to come from a licensed bakery.
- Can we have our ceremony here? Yes- the deck is available to host your ceremony. You are responsible for tables/chairs, tents & any décor.
- Do you have a liquor license? Can we bring in our own alcohol?

We do. - No alcoholic/non-alcoholic drinks may be brought in.

- Can we get ready at the venue? There is no designated space to get ready at the venue.
- What time can we arrive on-site? Day of packages grant you access to the hall from 8am-1am.
- Will there be a person from the venue on site all day/night? Yes. But we ask that you provide us with a timeline of vendor set ups/ drop offs in advance.
- What time do we have to get everything out of the venue after the reception? Your belongings need to be out of the venue no later than 1 am following your event.
- Does anyone from the venue help with moving decorations to/from the ceremony and reception locations?
 No. Moving your items is your responsibility.
- Are we allowed to use any vendors that we want? Yes.
- Does your venue offer day-of-coordination?
 No. Our staff is solely responsible for coordination of the venue- not outside vendors.
- Are there any décor restrictions?
 All décor must be approved by the venue. No glitter, confetti, bubbles, no command strips.
- Does your wedding venue allow real candles?
 We have a no open flame policy- real candles must be in a glass container of some sort- with at least 3 inches of glass above the flame.
- Do you allow fireworks? No fireworks will be tolerated. This includes sparklers & smoke bombs.
- Does someone from the venue maintain restrooms and garbage cans during the wedding reception? Yes.
