The affairs of the Association shall be managed by the Board of Directors of the Association as provided in, and in accordance with, the Bylaws of the Association.

ARTICLE 7 - Board Of Directors

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of three persons, and this number may be changed by a duly adopted amendment to the Bylaws, except that in no event may the number of directors

The members of the Board of Directors shall not be personally liable to the Association or to its members for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director; except that the foregoing shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a Director for: any breach of the Director's duty of loyalty to the Association or its members; acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; acts specified in C.R.S. Section 7-128-403; and any transaction from which the Director derived an improper personal benefit.

ARTICLE 9 - - Indemnification of Directors

Except for personal liability of a director pursuant to Article 8 above, and unless otherwise limited by the Colorado Common Interest Ownership Act, the Declaration of Condominium of Saddlebrooke at Rock Creek, or the Bylaws of the Association, the Directors shall be indemnified by the Association for any loss, damage, cost or expense incurred in the performance of their duties to the Association, including attorneys fees and costs, to the maximum extent permitted by law.

Amendment of the Articles shall require the assent of at least two-thirds of the weighted votes which members present at an annual or special meeting of members of the Association, or represented by proxy, are entitled to cast, as provided in the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act and the Declaration of Condominium for Saddlebrooke at Rock Creek to be recorded in the real estate records of Boulder County.
