- Shifts: Two 4.5-hour shifts per day (10 AM 2.30 PM, 2.30 PM 7 PM)

• **Responsibilities**: Help us visit 28,000 homes, distribute flyers, engage with residents, gather feedback.

4. Texting Campaign

- **Duration**: Flexible hours
- **Responsibilities**: Text your friends, neighbors, family, and other voters to (1) make them aware of Jim's upcoming speaking engagements and (2) remind them of important election-related details like start/end of early voting.
