

# AFTER FOX MANAGEMENT INTERVENTION

## 1. Implement fox management interventions

Implement the planned fox control interventions. If no fox activities were detected during the baseline survey (before), you may repeat the NNPS at that location. Or make an informed decision to continue monitoring that location in different seasons.

## 4. Adapt or continue as-is

The comparison provides valuable insights into the effectiveness of the implemented fox management interventions. This also provides opportunities to adapt the interventions if needed.

## 2. Repeat NNPS

Repeat NNPS. You and your team may determine a good time to set-up the repeat NNPS. ## 3. Compare with baseline data

Compare the nest predation rates before and after fox management. Assess any changes in predation rates, patterns, or predator species. This analysis will determine the effectiveness of the implemented fox management interventions.
