
Choose from the following lessons: (click on bold text)

<u>Turtle Morphology:</u> Classroom based lesson about freshwater turtle morphology, life cycle and habitat use.

Wetland Habitats: Wetland based lesson where students visit their local wetland, identify turtle habitats and assess the wetlands health.

<u>Turtle Threats:</u> Classroom based lesson about the threats to Australian freshwater turtle species.

National Nest Predation Survey: Wetland based activity where students create and monitor nest predation rates.
