Moving turtles found along roads

If you find a turtle along the road and you want to move it to safety - here are some key recommendations to keep you and the turtle safe.



Keep gloves in __ your car

Ensure they are clean and preferably single-use disaposable gloves




Have a Hi-Vis vest handy

We highly recommend having a hi-vis vest in your car and wearing it when moving the turtle



Use hand sanitiser before and after moving the turtle






Wear gloves

Ensure that you are wearing gloves at all times when moving the turtle

Do not move the turtle far

Avoid moving the turtle to a different or a location far from where they were spotted






Dispose used gloves responsibly
